University Model

Not consumer-driven

"Free" or heavily subsidized (\$567 billion/yr revenues)

\$1.5 trillion Debt Problem (avg. of \$37,000 debt per student)

4 Year Commitment (3.9 Years = No Degree)

Impersonal, generic

Promotes theories & formulas, sense of conformity

Restrictive licensing controls; favorable to jobs in gov't, medical, legal

Lots of confusing "policies," less academic freedom

Myth of "college value" (selection bias)

University Model Finish

Graduate to tough marketplace with No Work Experience, No Pay during 4 years of classroom books & lectures, Major Debt Problem
