Student pays for training -
cheaper, focused, best results

No Debt (paid while working)

Series of 3 to 6 Month Agreements
during 1 to 2 year "Transition Period"*

Personal, customized

Promotes critical thinking,
creative problem solving

favorable to jobs in business & mfg.

Clear & few common-sense rules,
more academic freedom

University Model

Not consumer-driven

"Free" or heavily subsidized
(\$567 billion/yr revenues)

\$1.5 trillion Debt Problem
(avg. of \$37,000 debt per student)

4 Year Commitment
(3.9 Years = No Degree)

Impersonal, generic

Promotes theories & formulas,
sense of conformity

Restrictive licensing controls;
favorable to jobs in gov't, medical, legal

Lots of confusing "policies,"
less academic freedom

Myth of "college value"
(selection bias)

Mentor Model Finish

Graduate to full-time salary after 1-2
years** with *diverse* work experience,
"learn & apply" engagement while
earning \$10-15/hr pay, and No Debt

University Model Finish

Graduate to tough marketplace with
No Work Experience, No Pay during
4 years of classroom books & lectures,
Major Debt Problem

* Transition Period for Jr. Staff: Replace the last 1-2 years of a typical 4-Year College Degree with a similar time of both academic study & on-the-job training while the **Jr. Staff also gets paid**.

** The Mentor Model is designed to begin after 1-2 years of College. Students can be any age.
